Pastoral Job Description and Responsibilities:

**General Responsibilities:**

The pastor is responsible for providing spiritual and administrative leadership to the heads of various church organizations and to the members of the church body. This individual is expected to possess and use appropriate skills in the proclaiming the gospel and providing pastoral care to meet the needs of RCMBC.

The pastor will preach the gospel, administer the ordinance, conduct special services, watch over the membership, and have charge of the spiritual welfare of the congregation. The Pastor will be responsible for all the other duties related to serving the congregation spiritually and administratively.

**Qualifications:**

- Shall meet the qualifications as stated in First Timothy 3: 1-7 and Titus 1: 7-9.
- Must be an ordained Baptist minister of the gospel, whose Christian and moral character is beyond question.
- Should have a minimum of BA/BS degree from an accredited institution of higher learning and preferably a master's degree from an accredited seminary or divinity school.
- Minimum of five (5) years of pastoral experience.
- Must display, possess, and exhibit administrative and leadership skills.
- Ordination or eligibility for licensure in this denomination.
- Must have proficient knowledge of Baptist doctrine, Church policies and procedures.
- Excellent communication skills/computer savvy.
- Passion for serving the church.

**Pastor's Duties:**

- Preach the gospel during worship services, administer the ordinance, conduct special services, watch over the membership, and have charge of the spiritual welfare of the congregation.
- Be an ex-officio member of all ministries, committees, and clubs.
- Shall be responsible for the pulpit ministry in his/her absence in cooperation with the Deacon Ministry and arrange for pulpit occupancy.
- Serve as head of all employed personnel.
- Appoint special committees as needed.
- Pastoral skills: home and hospital visitation, congregational care.
- Be responsible for all other duties related to serving the congregation spiritually and administratively.
